PUBLIC SAFETY STATEMENT

1. We want you to enjoy yourselves, but we also want you all to be safe. We would remind you that your children are your responsibility so please remember to supervise them at all times.

2. Traffic No Waiting Cones are placed in locations to assist the emergency services to, if required, gain access to the Feast Field and the Memorial Hall as well as keeping the main road clear. 3. The Feast Queen Parade takes place on public roads and parents are reminded that vehicles are included in the parade, including vintage tractors. 4. Should the emergency services need to pass through the village during the parade, please move to the left, off the road and onto the footpath, until the vehicle has past and the Marshalls indicate it is safe to continue.




