Harold Barker OATH TO BE TAKEN BY RECRUIT ON ATTESTATION.

I swear by Almighty God, that I will bear true Allegiance to His Majesty King George the Fifth, His Heirs and Successors, and that I will, to in duty bound, loyally and fully defend His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, in Person, Crown, and dignity against all enemies, and will observe all orders of His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, and of the Generals and Officers set over me.
