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THIS TRUST DEED is made the Sizeth " day of Secember One thousand nine hundred and thirty by HENRY CLOUGH of 21 Granville Road, Harrogate in the County of York Mineral Merchant THOMAS CARRINGTON of Top Farm Upper Altofts Normanton in the said Countyf Farmer WALTER HARRIS of "Forn Lea" Hampsthwaite near Harrogate aforesaid Cabinet Maker AMOS ADDYMAN of Greystone Plain, Hampsthwaite aforesaid Farmer FRED KAY of Springfield Swineliffe Top Hempsthwaite aforesaid Railway Ganger WILLIAM SILVERSIDES of Prospect Terrace Skipt on Road New Park Harrogate aforesaid Farmer JAMES BAREN of High Farm Rowden Lane Hampsthwaite aforesaid Farmer WILLIE FRANKLAND of Gill Thorn Farm Hampsthwaite aforesaid Farmer WILFRID YEADON of Moor Ferm Killinghall near Herrogate aforesaid Farm Bailiff JOSEPH ALLAN HARDCASTLE of Saltergate Hill Farm Killinghall aforesaid Farmer ERNEST WILFRED SUTTILL of Ripon Road - - - -Killinghall aforesaid Architect JOHN BELLERBY of Nidd House Farm Killinghall aforesaid Farmer JOHN MORRELL of Ripon Road Killinghall aforesaid Farm Bailiff THOMAS HOBKINSON Junior of 109 Gold Bath Road Harrogate aforesaid Railway Clerk and HARRY Swires of Red House Farm Hampsthwaite aforesaid Farmer (hereinafter called "the Trustees" which description shall - whenever the context so allows or requires be deemed to include the persons so designated herein and the survivors and survivor of them and also their and his successors in the trusts - hereinafter declared) WHEREAS by a Conveyance dated the Second day of December One thousand nine hundred and thirty and made between Dearlove Addyman of the one part and the Trustees of the other part the property described in the first Schedule hereto was conveyed unto the Trustees in fee simple as joint tenants upon the trusts hereinafter declared. AND WHEREAS the said property was purchased by the Trustees out of moneys provided by the members of the Saltergate Hill Mission and under an agreement whereby the Trustees were to enter into such declaration of trust as is hereinafter contained.

NOW THESE PRESENTS WITNESS as follows:-

- 1. The Trustees hereby declare that they stand seised of the said property described in the First Schedule hereto upon the following trusts namely:-
 - (1) To erect thereon a building suitable for use as a Hall or Chapel together with a school and such other buildings as shall be found necessary or desirable as adjuncts thereto (all of which said buildings with the said plot of land are hereinafter collectively described as "The Trust -Property")
 - (2) To permit the said Hell or Chapel so erected to be used as a place of worship and the School and other buildings as a place of religious instruction and also for the --- promotion of such other religious educational or -- charitable social or philanthropic purposes as the -
 Trustees shall from time to time direct Provided always that the form of worship to be used and the preaching and instruction to be given therein shall be of a Protestant character and in conformity with the doctrines usually called "Emangelical" and which are set forth in the Second Schedule hereto.
 - (3) To charge pew rents (if the Trustees shall think it -desirable to do so) to allow collections or offerings to
 be taken at any or all of the services which may be held
 on the Trust Property for the purposes of the Society or
 Church worshipping there (which shall be known as "the
 Saltergate Hill Mission") and for the Sunday School and
 other departments of the Mission's work and to adopt or
 resort to any other approved method of raising funds for
 the purposes of the Mission.
 - (4) Out of the moneys to be received from pew rents collections or otherwise to pay all rates taxes insurance premiums repairs and charges for lighting heating and cleaning and all other outgoings which may from time to time be payable in respect of the Trust Property or any part thereof.
 - (5) To appoint (and remove at their discretion) any suitable person or persons to act as a Secretary and Treasurer of the Trust Property. The Secretary so appointed shall keep

Minutes of all Trustees' Meetings held under or by virtue of these presents and of the resolutions passed and - business done thereat and all such Minutes shall be read and confirmed and signed at the Trustees' Meeting held next after the Meeting to which they respectively relate. The said Treasurer shall keep proper accounts of all moneys received and paid hereunder and such accounts shall be audited every year and subsequently submitted to and approved by the Trustees.

- (6) To hold meetings for the transactionnof business in relation to the Trust Property at least once a year of all which meetings seven days' notice shall be given in writing.
- (7) To act by a majority of Trustees present at a meeting so convened and held. Five Trustees shall form a quorum.
- (8) If any of the Trustees hereby appointed or to be --hereafter appointed in pursuance of the power hereby
 given or under any statutory power or by any Court shall
 die or reside abroad for a year or desire to be -discharged from the Trust or refuse or become incapable
 to act or become bankrupt or cease to be a member of a
 Protestant Church to appoint at a meeting specially convened for this purpose another person or persons (being a member or members of The Saltergate Hill Mission
 or of some other Protestant Church) as a Trustee or
 Trustees in place of such deceased discharged or --incapacitated Trustee or Trustees as aforesaid and -thereupon to transfer the Trust Property so as to vest
 the same in the continuing Trustees hereunder and such
 new Trustee or Trustees.
- (9) To act (if they shall think fit) notwithstanding vacancies in their body until the number of Trustees shall be reduced by the events aforesaid to seven whereupon a new trustee or trustees shall be appointed in manner aforesaid.
- (10) To raise any sum or sums of money by mortgage or charge of the Trust Property or any part thereof at such rates of interest on such terms and from such persons as the

Trustees may think fit.

- (11) To sell the Trust Property or any part thereof either
 by Public Auction or Private Treaty if requested to do
 so by a majority of the members for the time being of
 The Saltergate Hill Mission and to apply the net moneys
 to arise from such sale in payment of any sums owing on
 mortgage or charge of the Trust Property or any part
 thereof and all other liabilities in connection therewith
 and to use the balance thereof in or towards the erection
 of a more convenient Hall or Chapel School and other
 buildingsfor the use of the said Mission or failing this
 to pay the said balance in accordance with the terms of
 clause 12 hereunder.
- (12) To offer to transfer the Trust Property to the Harrogate

 Circuit of the Methodist Church in any of the undermentioned events:
 - (a) If after the consummation of the proposed union of the Wesleyan Methodist, Primitive Methodist and United Methodist Churches the members of The Saltergate Hill Mission shall pass a resolution in favour thereof.
 - (b) If ah any time the number of members of The Saltergate Hill Mission shall be reduced to three.
 - (c) If the members of The Saltergate Hill Mission shall pass a resolution for its own dissolution or for departing from the doctrines hereinbefore mentioned.
 - (d) If public worship upon the Trust Property shall be discontinued for a period of twelve calendar months (except for the purpose of re-building or repairs).
- (13) If the said Circuit shall be unwilling to take over the Trust Property then and in such case the Trustees shall sell the same.
- (14.) In the last-mentioned event the Trustees shall pay put of the proceeds of such sale the expenses of the sale and all moneys owing on the security of the Trust Property and all costs charges and expenses paid or incurred by the Trustees or any of them in relation to the Trusts hereof and to divide the -

residue thereof equally between The Wesleyan Methodist
Local Preachers' Mutual Aid Association and The National
Children's Home & Orphanage. The receipt of the -respective treasurers of these organisations shall be a
sufficient discharge to the Trustees for such payment.

3. SUBJECT to the provisions of this deed The Saltergate Hill Mission may from time to time make such rules for the --- management of its affairs as its members may from time to time think fit.

IN WITNESS whereof the said parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first - hereinbefore written.
